In response to the increasing demand of courier services focusing on small quantity business-to-business individual packages containing chilled and/or frozen goods for direct delivery to the customer, the first international publicly available specification related to chilled and/or frozen goods delivery services commenced by BSI, i.e. PAS 1018: 2017, was upgraded to ISO 23412: 2020 in May 2020.

It aims to be a guideline for refrigerated and delivery service providers to support consumer safety through a total control of the cold chain while the refrigerated parcel is in possession of the refrigerated delivery service provider. Food is one item that may be delivered, but not the only type of good delivered using this method.

- Develop a plan and determine the resources required for the implementation
- Apply good practice to the implementation using proven tools and techniques
